Joko reflects briefly before delving into his past.

JOKO

(While breathing in and out)

Alright, actually, I haven't been as successful as people say, but what I have gained so far comes from my first day on the new college campus.

SARAH

(sounds curiosity)

OK, tell me how you got to where you are now.

FLASHBACK:

JOKO (V.O.)

(reflecting)

Little did they know, my journey was just beginning.

The camera pans out, revealing the diverse student body, each facing a potential ally or rival in Joko's unfolding story.

4. INT. CLASSROOM - DAY

JOKO, dressed in modest clothes, walks through the luxurious school hallway, glancing at his classmates in designer outfits. He hesitates before entering a classroom filled with students showing off their latest gadgets and accessories.

CLASSMATE #1

(whispering)

He's the scholarship guy, right? I don't think he's an ordinary person who can receive a special scholarship at this campus.

CLASSMATE #2

(smiled faintly)

I agree, if he takes part in a business competition, we can know whether he can prove himself or not.

The class seems to be paying attention to Joko, Joko notices that and looks around but no one wants to talk to him and Joko returns to focusing on the course explanation.

6. INT. UNIVERSITY OFFICE - DAY

After the lecture, the lecturer approaches Joko, who invites him to her office. Joko, feeling nervous, agrees and follows her.

MONTAGE:

- A. Joko packs his bags swiftly.
- B. He walks down the corridor, trailing behind his lecturer.
- C. They enter the lecturer's office.

END MONTAGE

Inside the office, Lecturer 2, a business lecturer, warmly greets Joko with a smile and a handshake.

LECTURER #2

Hello, Joko.

JOKO

(smiling back)

Hello, ma'am. (shakes hand)

LECTURER #2

I've heard you're the student with the special scholarship here. Is that correct?

JOKO

Yes, ma'am.

LECTURER #2

Great. In the coming weeks, we'll be hosting a business plan competition training selection on

MONTAGE:

9. INT. BOARDING HOUSE - EVENING

Joko arrives at his boarding house, puts down his things and lays down. Joko opens his cellphone and calls his mother.

JOKO'S MOM (INTERCUT)

Hi, Joko?

JOKO

(Smiling)

Hi mom, how are you there, I'm fine here.

JOKO'S MOM

I'm good. Sorry, I can't give you more money because your father is sick, but I'm happy that you are fine.

JOKO

(turns gloomy)

Mom, later, when I get employment and earn an income, I will make you proud and will never give up. Tell dad to be strong. I hope he gets well soon.

JOKO'S MOM

Yes, sweetheart, dad will definitely recover. How about your college? Are you able to adapt well there? Do you have many friends?

Joko is silent for a moment and thinks, then answers his mother and assures her that everything will be fine.

JOKO

(slightly smiles)

My study life here is quite hard; the people here are all rich and I am the only one who received a scholarship and also has poor status. But I am here because I got a scholarship. JOKO

(in unison)

11. INT. OFFICE ROOM - DAY

Joko, Rian, and Rachel come to meet their mentor, SISCA (29). Joko gives the results of their business plan. After Sisca reads and sees their design, Sisca's face looks confused and unhappy.

SISCA  
(Confuses)

What is this?

JOKO  
(confuses)

What does it mean? That is our business plan, ma'am.

SISCA  
(Firm)

What kind of business is this? Its origins are still unclear, whereas you can see here that the market analysis you provide is still not in-depth in terms of impact, targets, and shortcomings. Did the three of you have a good discussion? I want this to be quickly revised and further analyzed on this important matter. Let's work harder, Joko and the others, okay?

JOKO  
But do you think this is a business plan that could look as good?

SISCA  
(sighing)

Joko, remember, analysis and discussion with friends are the solutions. You must be able to discuss it with your friends and be confident in your group's analysis, which is key. I'm sure if that's what you do, then whatever work you do, the results will definitely be optimal.

JOKO

RACHEL

(Sarcastic laugh)

JOKO

SERIES OF SHOTS:

- B. Joko sips his drink.

- F. Joko checks his phone for messages.
- G. Joko stretches and takes a deep breath.

RAFAEL

JOKO

Rafael then leaves, Joko returns to prepare their presentation and various groups arrive in the hall to compete.

#### 16. INT. CAMPUS HALL - DAY

SERIES OF SHOTS:

- A. The audience claps politely.
- B. Joko fidgets with his notes.
- C. Rian and Rachel exchange worried looks.
- D. The host continues talking animatedly.
- E. Joko takes a deep breath, trying to calm himself.
- F. The other groups prepare their materials.
- G. Joko wipes his sweaty palms on his pants.

The host starts calling each group to present their work.  
Joko breathes heavily.

RIAN

Joko, are you okay? You look pale.

JOKO

I'm fine, I just haven't eaten yet.

RACHEL

Are you sure you'll be alright?

The presenter calls Joko's group to the stage. Joko steps forward, introducing himself and his group.

JOKO

JOKO (CONT'D)

JOKO

Joko sinks back onto his bed, running a hand through his hair in disbelief. He apologizes to Rian and Rachel.

JOKO (CONT'D)

Rian, Rachel... I'm sorry for all of this. I didn't expect any of this to happen, but I'll make it right.

RIAN

(sighs)

It's too late now. I'm disappointed, Joko. I thought you were different, but you've shown you're selfish and unwilling to listen.

RACHEL

Have you never faced failure before? It's not about always winning; it's about how you handle setbacks. You've damaged your reputation.

Joko sits in silence as Rian and Rachel leave the room, leaving him alone. He cries quietly for a moment before gathering himself and leaving the health center.

18. EXT. CAMPUS - AFTERNOON

END OF FLASHBACK:

19. INT. STUDIO - DAY (Present)

In the studio, it sounds quiet and tense, Joko wipes a few tears from his eyes and Sarah looks serious and feels sad about Joko's past.

JOKO

(slightly laugh)

Haha... I'm sorry, Sarah, to have a sad moment like this.

SARAH

It is totally fine. It is precisely through this friend that we can know that even someone who is successful has to go through moments of ups and downs. Applause to everyone.

Applause and shouts of cheers from the crew behind the camera and also Sarah. Then finally, Joko laughs, and then Joko tells the story of the moment where he lives the rest

of his college life well and continues his career and new business after graduating.

JOKO

OK, the story continues, and this is the rest of my life during college and how I boldly pursued a career after graduating, worked, and saved for my new business. Sarah, are you ready to hear me?

SARAH

(surely smiles)

With grace, I am ready to accept all your stories, Joko.

FLASHBACK:

20. INT. CLASSROOM - MORNING
