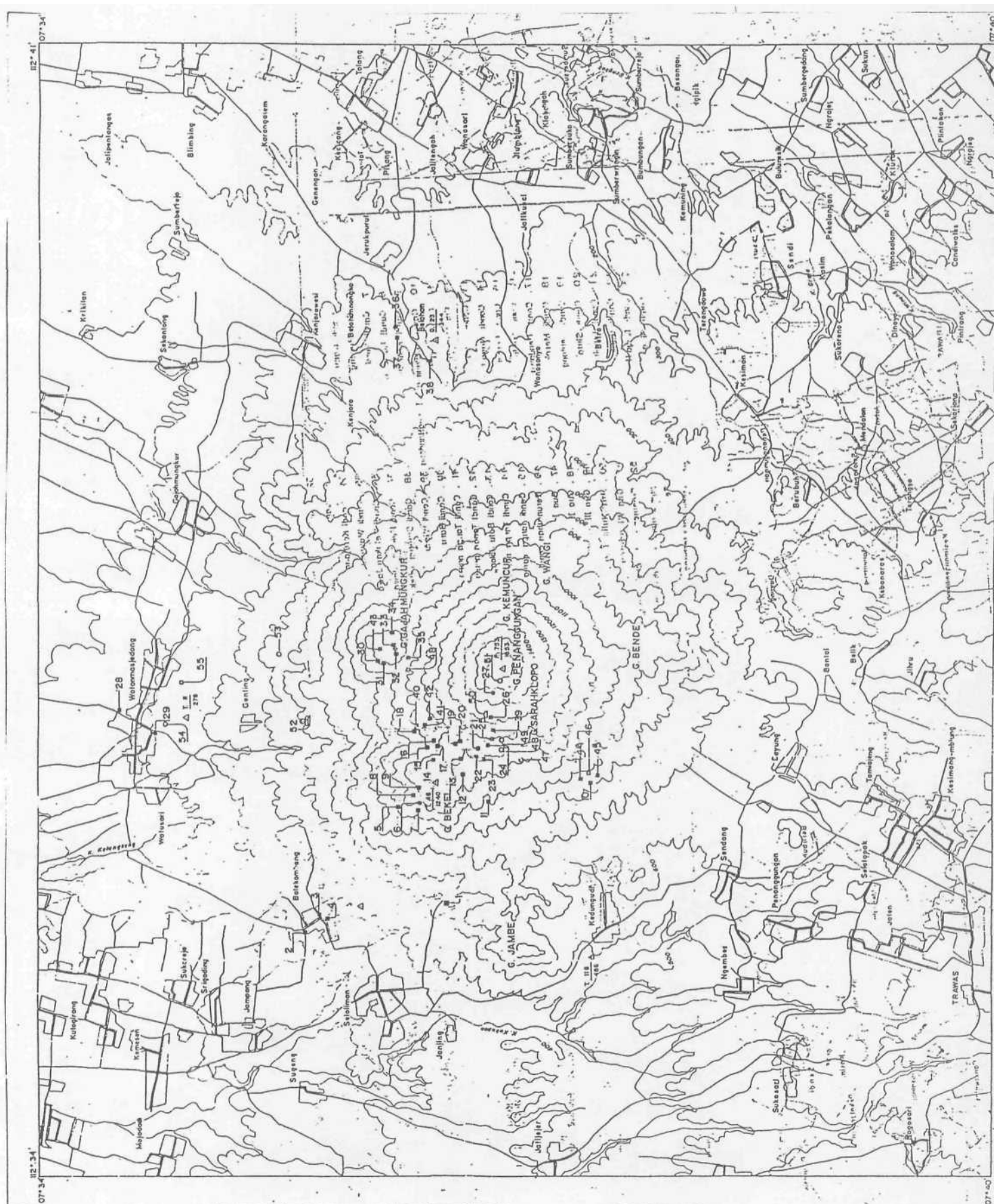
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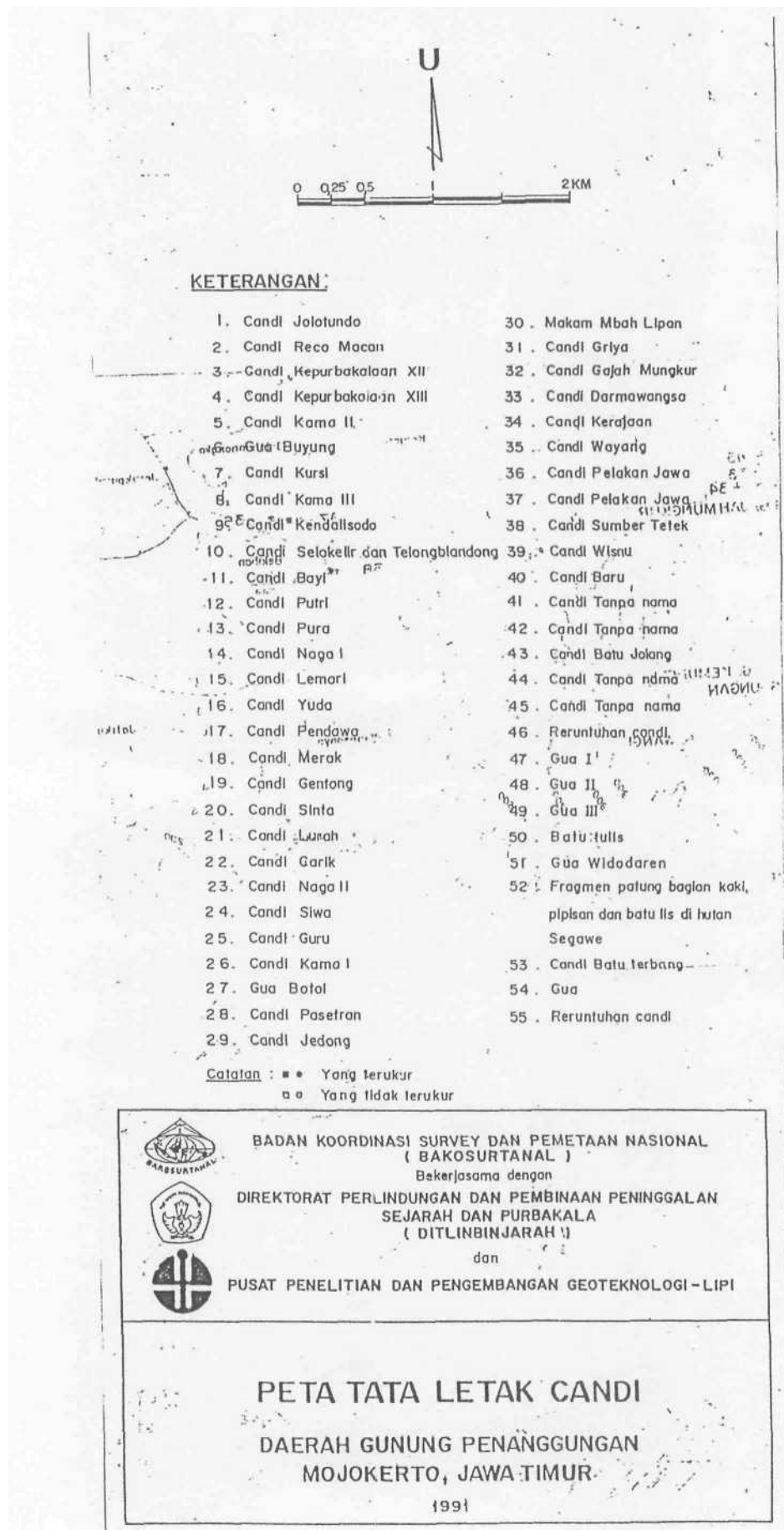
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Lampiran I a : Peta Tata Letak Candi

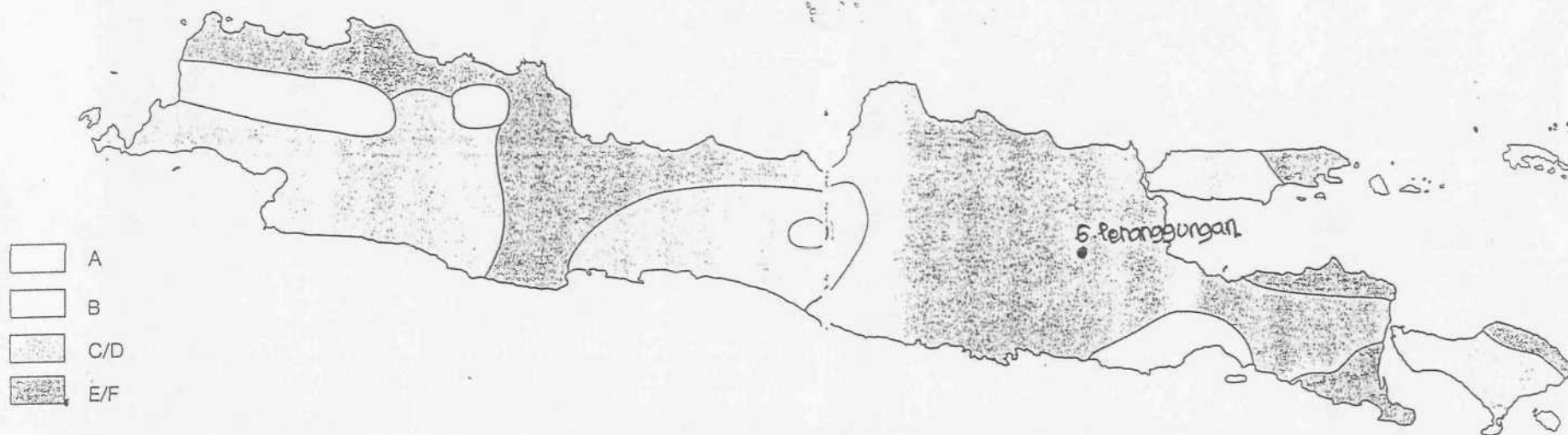
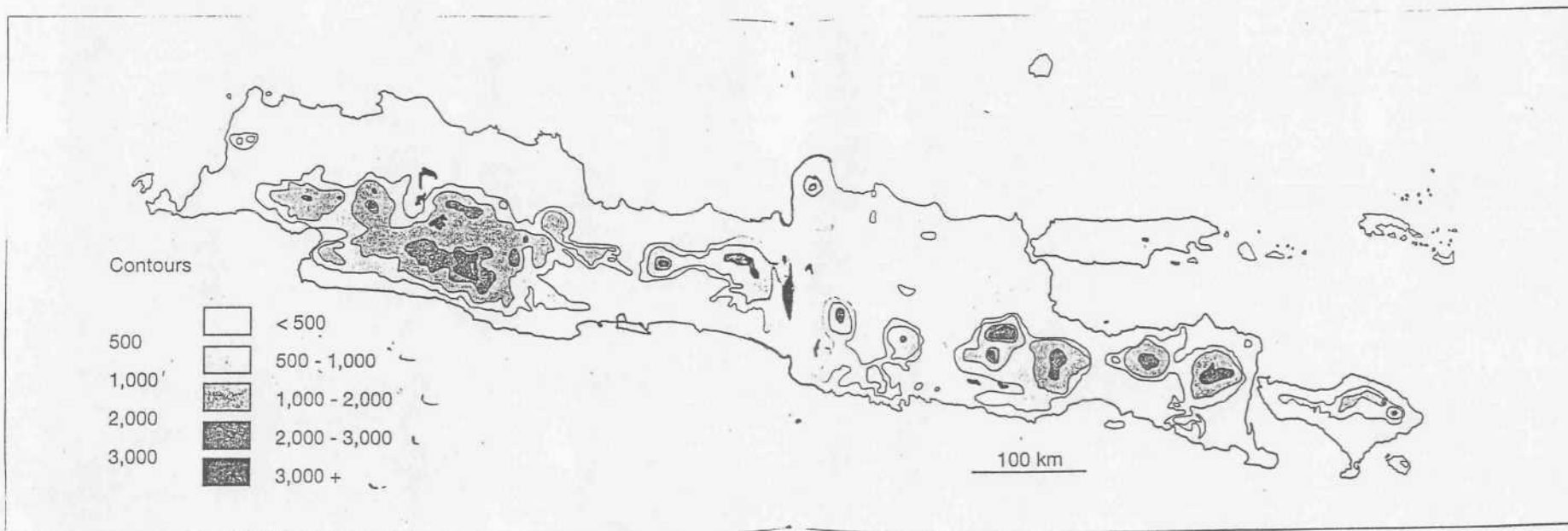


Table 3.6. The six categories of the Schmidt-Ferguson climate classification encountered on Java and Bali.

Climate type	Category	Percentage (Q) of wet months to dry months
Perhumid	A	Q = 0-14%
Slightly seasonal	B	Q = 14-33%
Seasonal	C	Q = 33-60%
Seasonal	D	Q = 60-100%
Strongly seasonal	E	Q = 100-167%
Strongly seasonal	F	Q = 167-300%

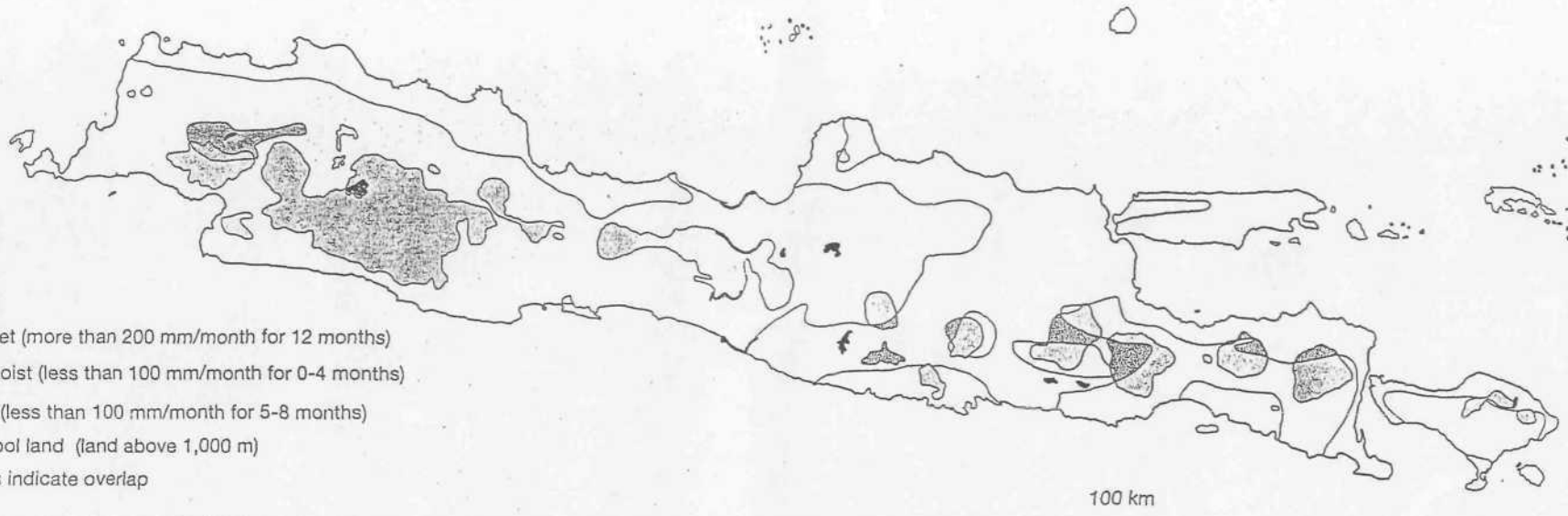
Lampiran III : Contour Map of Java And Bali



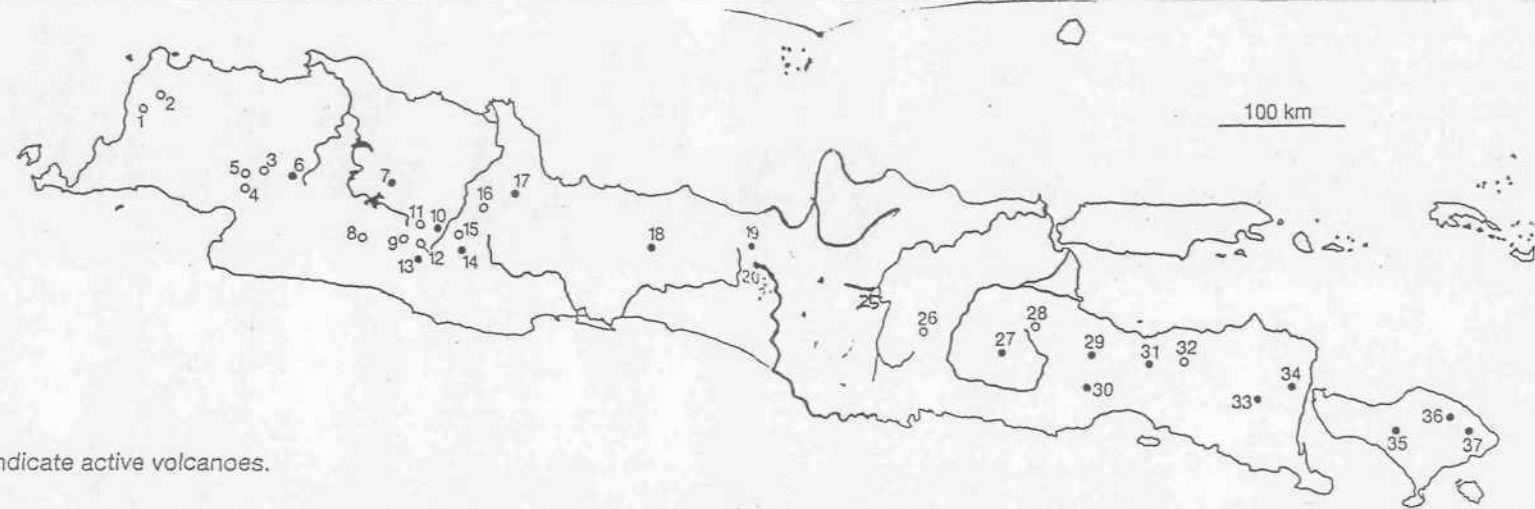
Lampiran IV : Aromatic Zones And Black Circles Indicate Active Volcanoes

Microclimatic zones

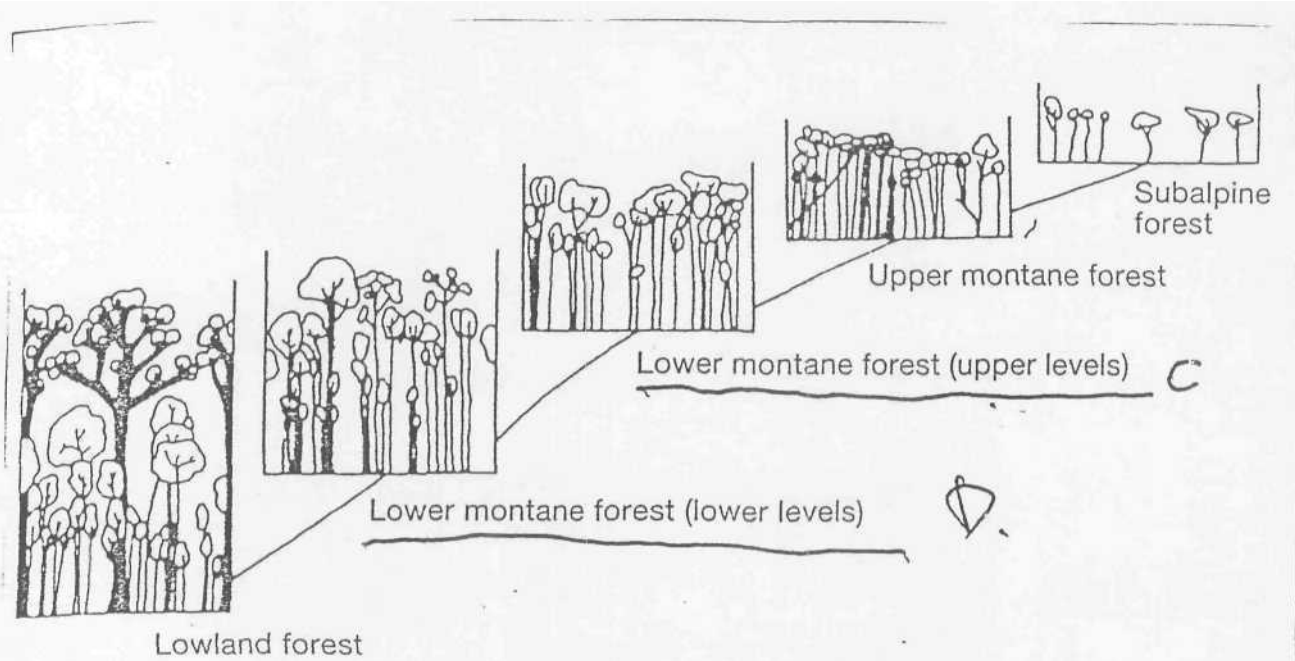
- Permanently wet (more than 200 mm/month for 12 months)
- Permanently moist (less than 100 mm/month for 0-4 months)
- Seasonally dry (less than 100 mm/month for 5-8 months)
- Permanently cool land (land above 1,000 m)
- Speckled areas indicate overlap



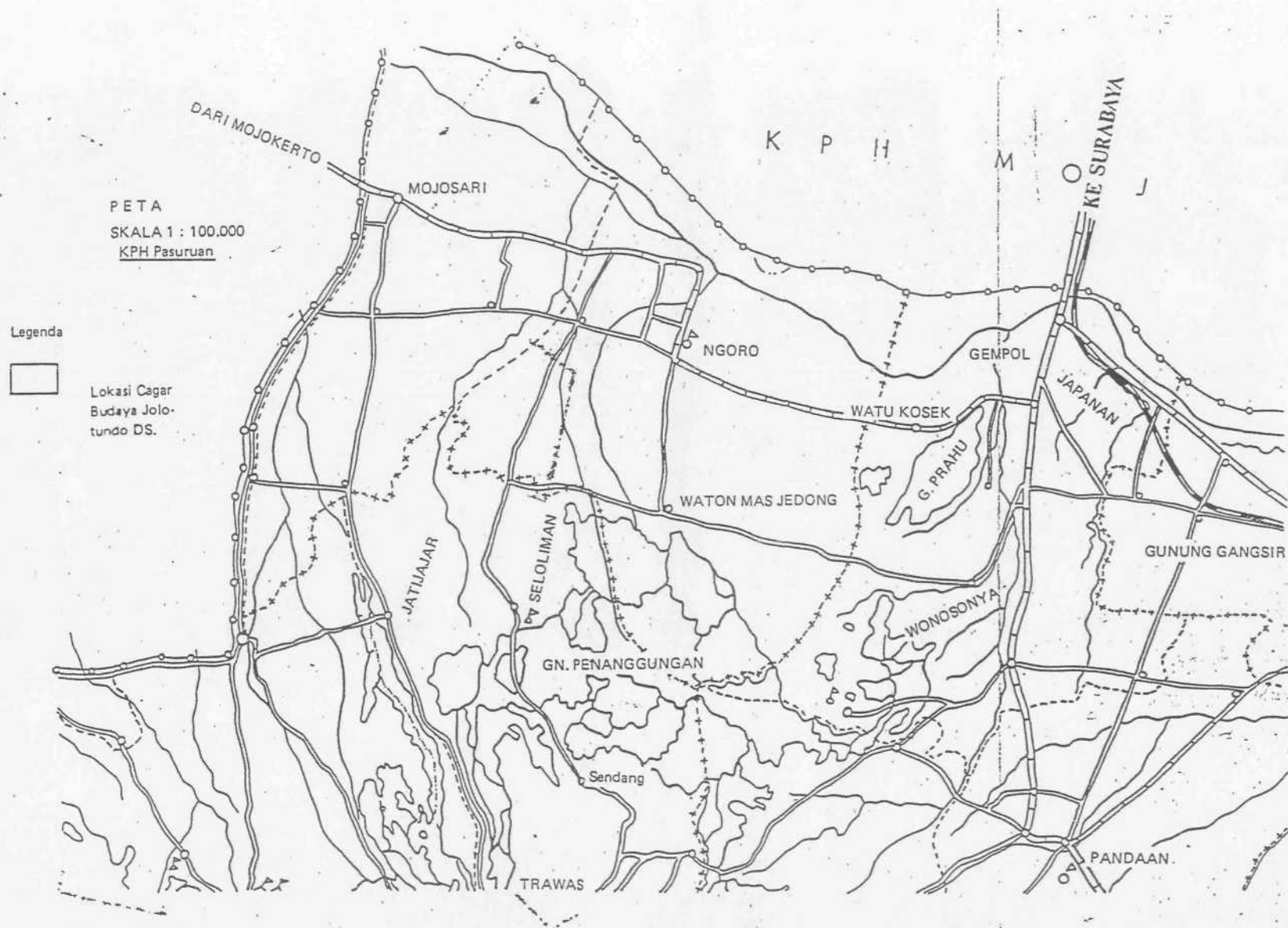
Black circles indicate active volcanoes.

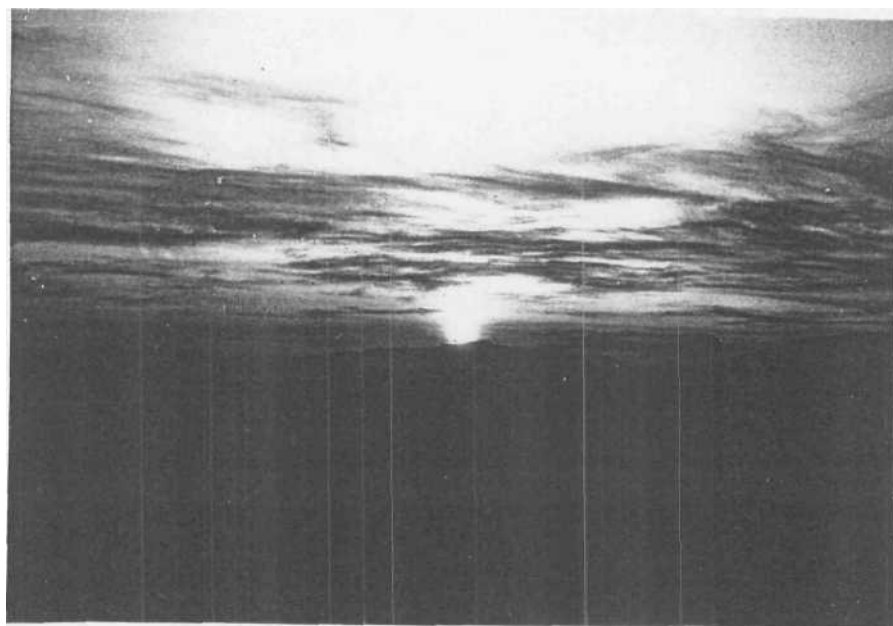

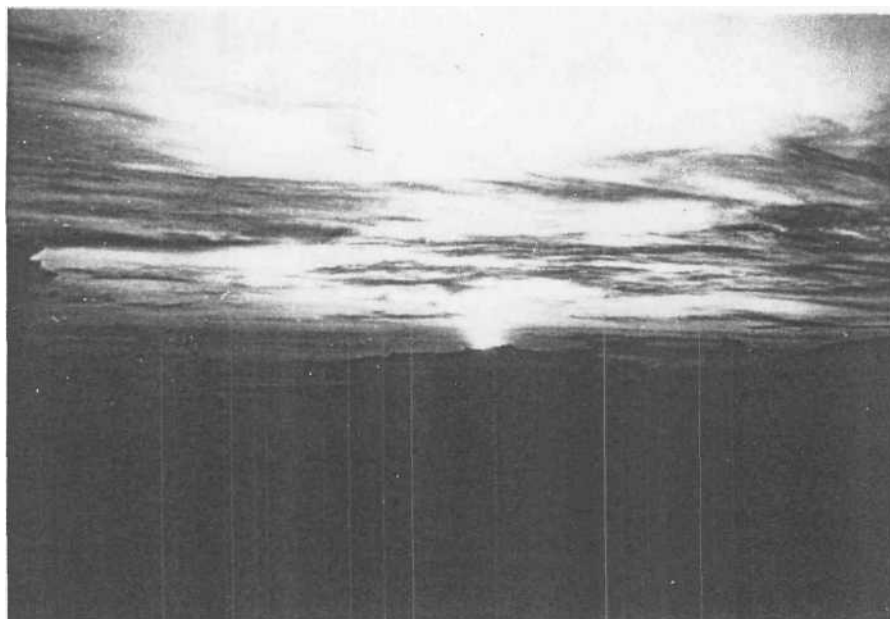

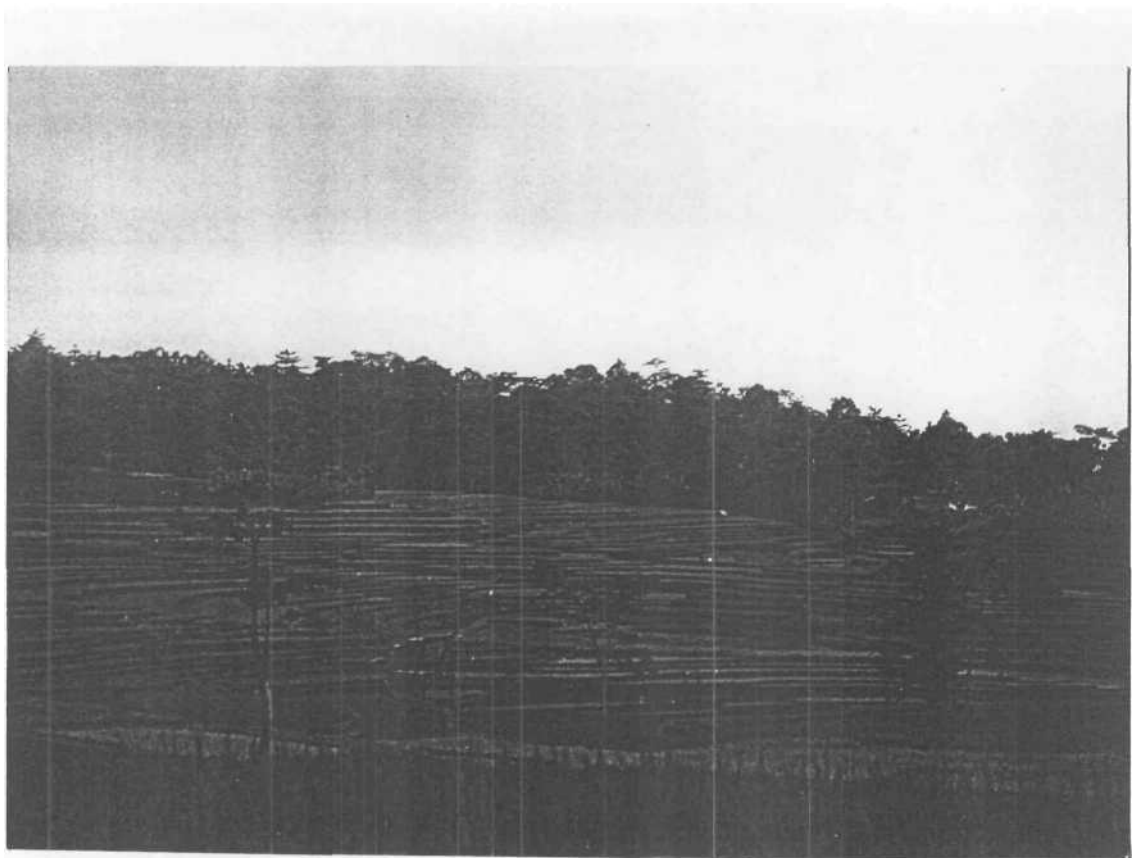




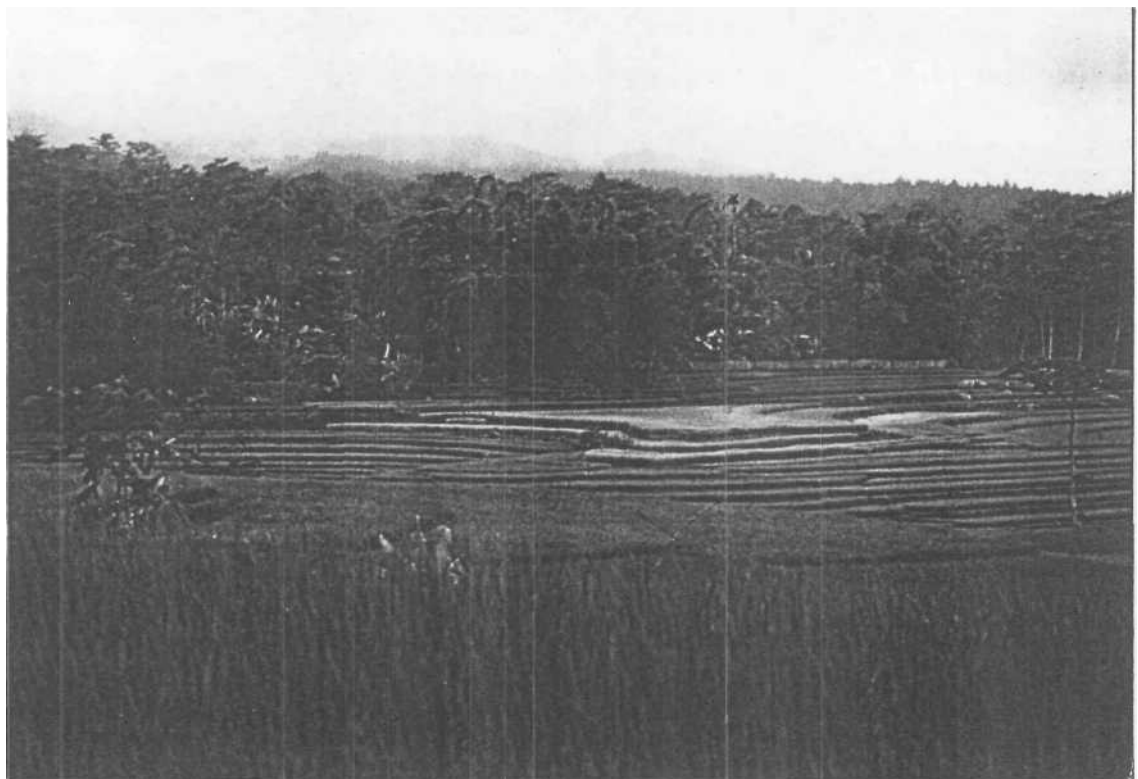
Gambar I: Pemandangan Matahari Terbit
Dari Atas Gunung Penanggungan



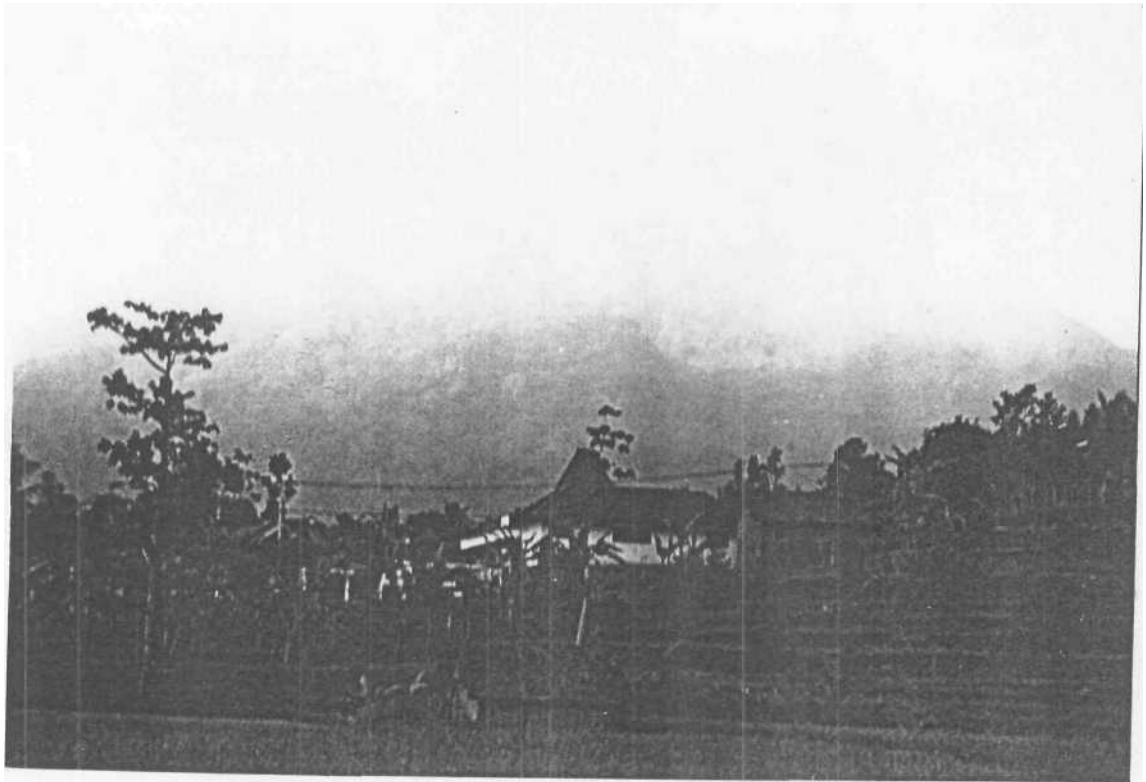
Gambar II: Pemandangan Matahari Terbit
Dari Atas Gunung Penanggungan



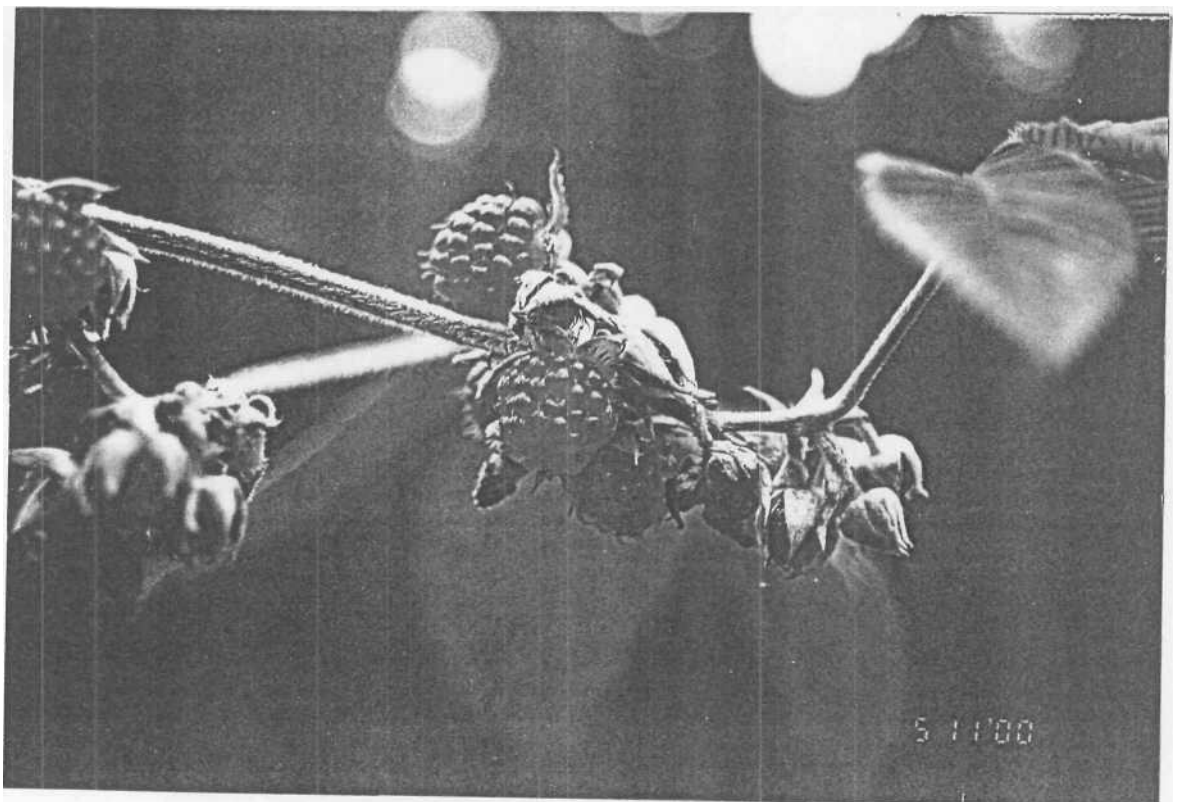
Gambar III: Pemandangan Sawah Dari Desa Sendang



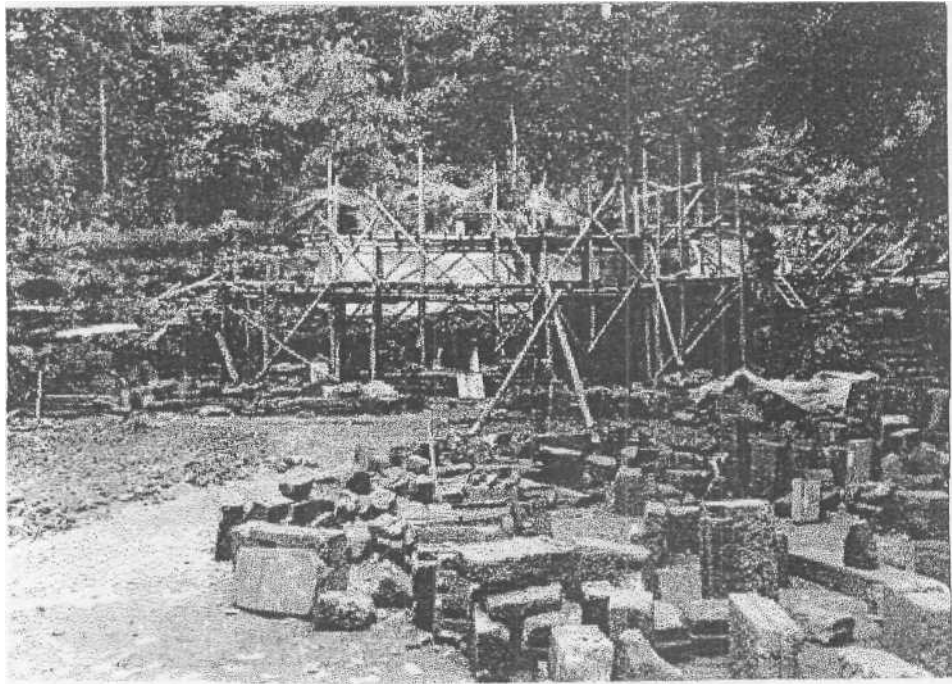
Gambar IV : Pemandangan Sawah Dari Desa Sendang



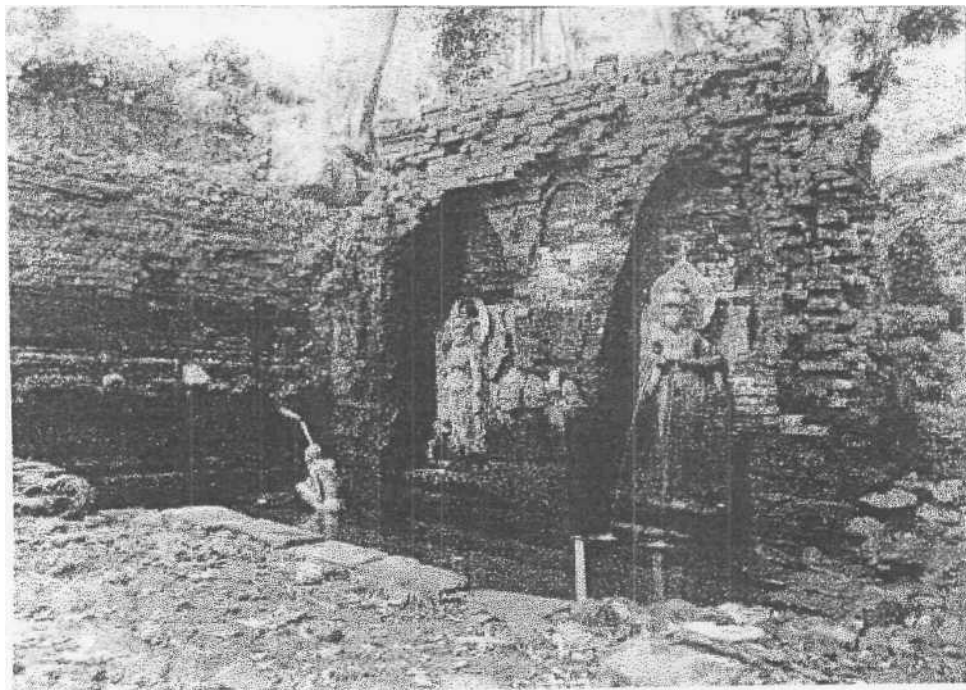
Gambar V : Pemandangan Gunung Penanggungan
Dari Desa Tamiajeng



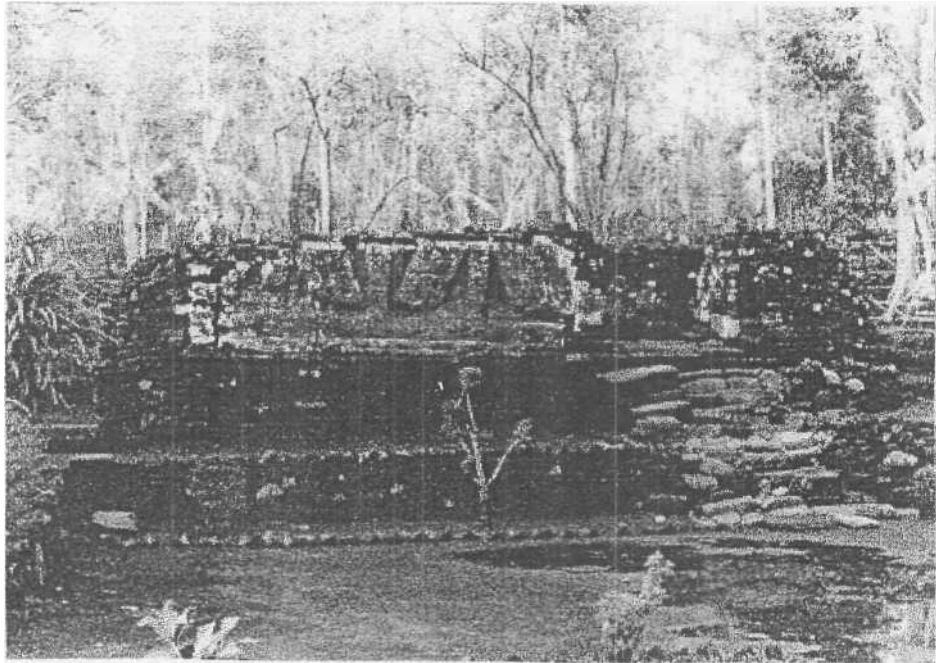

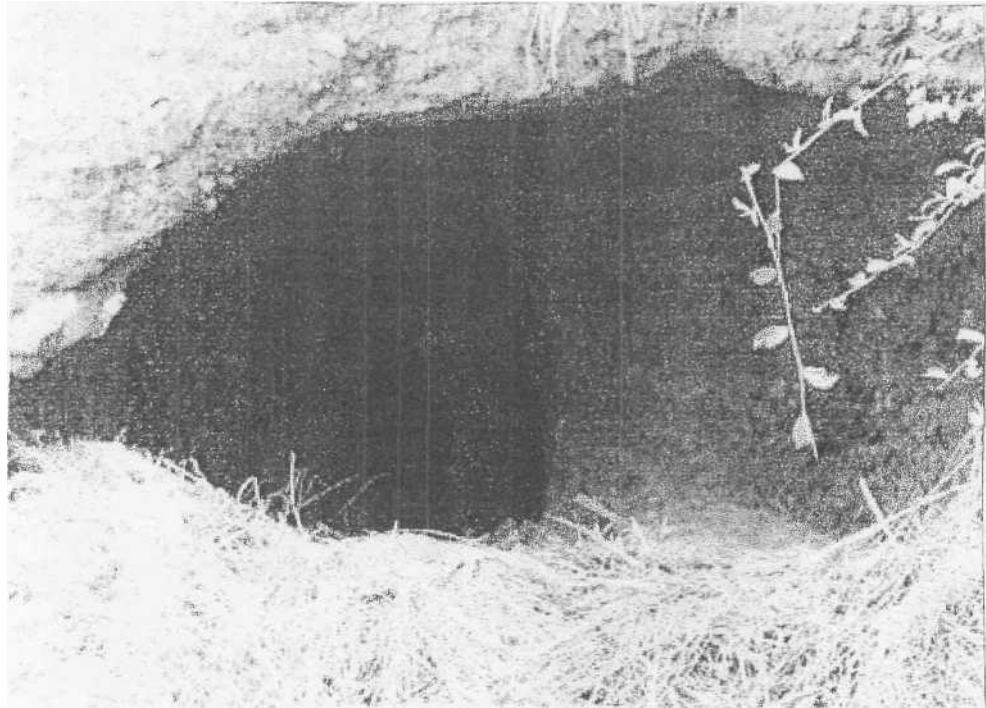


Gambar XII: Candi Putri

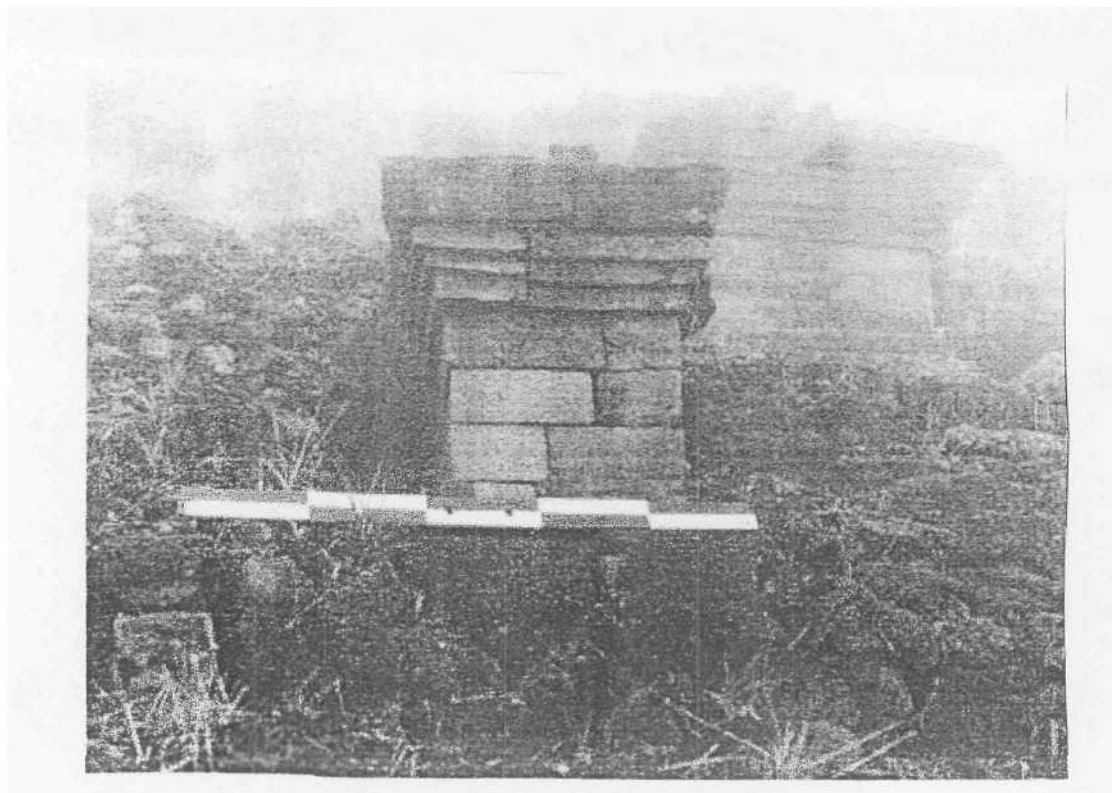
