We've got no queue system to dine-in. No queue system for payment either. We can only manage to "slide-in" into the table as soon as the other customer finished their meals. The staff was helpful but not at the peak hours, they're too busy.</p>

Nasi campur consists of shrimps, egg balado, empal (fried marinated beef chunks), stir fry salty vegetable and of course the iconic sambal bu Rudy. Other dishes are nasi bakar (grill banana leaf wrapped rice) with choice of fillings.
