

5. CONCLUSION

This research is about swear words expressed by ten actors of *Jackass: the Movie*. The writer would like to know the kinds of swear words uttered by the ten actors of *Jackass: the Movie* and the most kinds of swear words stated by them. Moreover, the writer would like to know the reasons of swearing and the most reason that were used by the actors. The writer took the theories from Liedlich (1973), Hughes (1991), Wardhaugh (1986) and Wyld (1936).

This research is a descriptive research and was analyzed in several steps. After the writer analyzed all of the research questions, the writer found the findings.

With regard to the swear words expressed by the actors of *Jackass: the Movie*, it was found that there are eight kinds of swear words expressed by the actors of *Jackass: the Movie*. The eight kinds of swear words are copulative term, related to human genital term, Christ's words term, excretory term, death term, sexual irregularities term, plant term and animal term.

With regard to the swear words mostly expressed by the actors, it was found that copulative term (35%) was the most preferred swear words expressed by the actors. The least preferred swear term expressed by the actors was animal term (1%).

With regard to the reasons of swearing used by the actors of *Jackass: the Movie*, it was found that there is only one reason of swearing. The only reason of swearing is expressing emotions.

With regard to the most reason of swearing used by the actors of *Jackass: the Movie*, it was found that expressing emotions (100%) was the most preferred reason.

This present research was a small scale one which surveyed only 10 actors of reality show. Further research could be conducted on a larger scale where different movies such as *MTV Whatever things or Dirty Monkey* could be included. A larger number of subjects would lend further reliability to results obtained.

Hopefully, the findings of the present study could be useful in providing understanding about swear words and this research would be beneficial for those who engage in the same practice.
